These observations, which exclude four students who copied assignment solutions, raise the following points of interest:

- Only three of the 44 students who submitted 5 or 6 assignments failed the course; one of these students had consistently weak term work and missed a quiz for illness, another had assignment marks consistently higher than quiz and exam marks.
  - All of the 19 students with a final mark of 70% or greater submitted 5 or 6 assignments.
- Four of the 8 students with a failing final mark submitted 2 or fewer assignments.
  - The highest final mark was 59% among students submitting 2 or fewer assignments.
- The summary at the right of the more detailed table above shows the relationship between final grade and number of assignments submitted; the overall ‘slope’ of this relationship is about 3 percentage points of average final grade per assignment submitted.
- The average number of assignments submitted was 4.95 (82%) and the average assignment mark (out of 10) was about 7.69 (77%).
  - The product (about 63%) of these two percentages suggests that the ‘average’ student in the course demonstrated competence in *approaching two-thirds* of the assignment material.
